“Today’s Bordeaux,” a promotion in collaboration with Sopexa and the Bordeaux Wine Council (CIVB), has selected Château Puy-Blanquet as part of the “Today’s Bordeaux Top 100” list.

The campaign highlights **affordable Bordeaux wines** priced between \$9 and \$35 retail. After a blind tasting, the Top 100 wines were selected by a team of wine experts from around the country, alongside two judges chosen for their work as restaurateurs and sommeliers.

**90 pts.**, “A balanced and delicious budget Bordeaux from a great vintage. Shows aromas of tar, berry, and blackberries. It’s medium to full body with fine tannins and a long finish. The fresh acidity balance to this is very attractive. Drink or hold.” - J.S., JamesSuckling.com, 6.6.12

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Overlooking the Dordogne valley in the heart of Saint-Etienne de Lisse, Château Puy-Blanquet has northern and eastern blocks that enjoy the morning sunshine. There are 49 acres of planted acreage on soils of clay and chalk. Château Puy-Blanquet has the special distinction of belonging to Etablissements Jean-Pierre Moueix, and the wine is an MMD exclusive product.

The 2009 blend is 75% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon.
