Originally created in 1876 for Tsar Alexander II of Russia, Cristal was crafted as the first prestige cuvée in history.

Louis Roederer owns over 560 acres located in the Grand Cru and Premier Cru regions of Champagne. Cristal is 100% estate-bottled.

Legendary  
craftsmanship

An average of five years of aging on the lees, and a minimum of eight months after disgorging gives Cristal its legendary finesse and elegance.

Cristal's bottle was originally made of crystal; its packaging has undergone minimal changes since its first release.
